How do you tell the males from females?

Adult male sea lions can be recognized by the sagittal crest, the high forehead. Males can be 2–4 times bigger than females!



What color is a sea lion's fur?

When sea lions are wet, they are dark brown. When dry, females are sandy blond and males are a chocolate brown.

Fast Facts:

- Swim up to 15 mph
- Dive up to 900 feet
- Dive up to 10 minutes
- Can slow heartbeat while diving from 90 to 20 beats per minute !



What do sea lions use their teeth for?



Sea lions mainly use their teeth to catch fish, squid or crustaceans AND for defense.
